Donor's Rights

- 1. To be informed of the Galiano Conservancy Association's (the Conservancy's) mission, of the way the Conservancy intends to use donated resources, and of its capacity to use donations effectively for their intended purposes.
- 2. To be informed of the identity of those serving on the Conservancy's governing board, and to expect the board to exercise prudent judgment in its responsibilities.
- 3. To have access to the Conservancy's most recent financial statements.
- 4. To be assured their gifts will be used for the purposes for which they were given.
- 5. To receive appropriate acknowledgment and recognition.
- 6. To be assured that information about their donations is handled with respect and with confidentiality to the extent provided by law.
- 7. To expect that all relationships with individuals representing the Conservancy will be professional in nature.
- 8. To be informed whether those seeking donations are volunteers or employees of the Conservancy.
- 9. To be assured by the Conservancy that their names will not be shared with any other organization.
- 10. To feel free to ask questions when making a donation and to be assured that questions will be answered in a prompt and complete manner.
