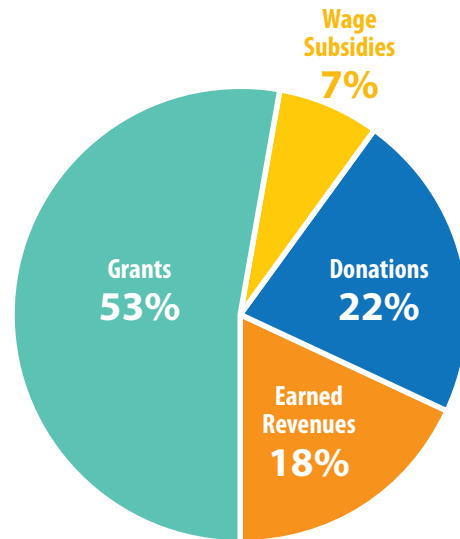


FINANCIAL LANDSCAPE FOR 2018

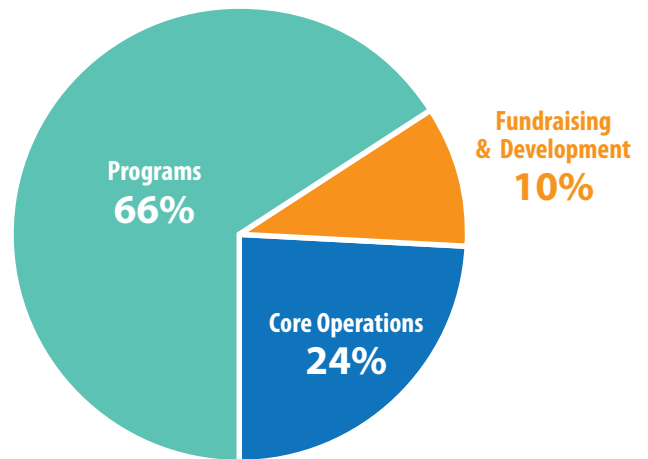
Revenue (does not include sale of residential property)
