11:05 – 11:30	Drive to Millard Learning Centre Crystal Cove Site. Need on-island transportation? Rent our bus! Seats up to 54 small students or 36 adults.
11:30 – 11:45	Welcome & Introductions
11:45 – 12:15	Lunch at Crystal Cove Beach! Food not provided, please bring your own packed lunch.
12:15 – 1:30	Hike to Ridgeline Viewpoint collecting native plants for tea.
