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## **Backcountry Experience Itinerary**

2 Day, 1 (or 2) Night Program

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<u>Day 1</u>	
10:10 AM	<b>Ferry leaves Tsawwassen Terminal.</b> Typically the Victoria, Swartz Bay ferry arrives on Galiano around 11:45AM. Click here for <u>BC Ferry schedules</u>
11:05 AM	<b>Ferry arrives at Sturdies Bay Galiano Island.</b> Foot passengers disembark first.
11:05 – 11:30	<b>Drive to the Millard Learning Centre.</b> Need on-island transportation? Rent our bus! Seats up to 54 small students or 36 adults.
11:40 - 11:55	Welcome & Site Orientation  Your class will be camping at our 188-acre Millard Learning Center. Stay at either our Frontcountry or Backcountry campsite.
11:55 – 12:30	Lunch
12:30 – 1:00	Gear sign out & set up camp We have a full supply of tents, sleeping mats, sleeping bags, hiking bags, day bags, and camp stoves all donated by Mountain Equipment Co-op!
1:00 – 1:30	Bag-packing discussion and pack bags
1:30 - 1:45	Bus from the Millard Learning Centre to Laughlin Lake
2:00 – 3:00	Hike to Pebble Beach through plantation forest to mature forest
3:00 – 3:15	Snack break on beautiful Pebble Beach
3:15 – 4:45	Hike from Pebble Beach to the Millard Learning Centre (~7km total) Students will see ecosystem changes as we go from sea level to 120m ridge and back down to the Millard Learning Centre.

4:45 – 5:00	Explanation of camp cooking etiquette & leave no trace and how to operate MSR stoves  Student cook groups (4 people/group) will have pre-planned all their food and meals for this 3 day trip. They will use MSR cook stoves to cook each meal.
5:00 PM	GCA Staff depart
<u>Day 2</u>	
7:30 – 8:00	Rise and Shine!
8:00 - 9:20	Breakfast & Clean-up
9:20 - 10:00	Pack up camp and clean campsite
10:00	GCA Staff arrive
10:00 – 10:30	Check in & gear inventory
10:30 - 11:30	Orienteering and compasses activities
11:30- 12:00	Native Plant Teaching Train walk down to Crystal Cove Students teach and learn from one another, becoming masters of native plant identification!
12:00 – 1:00	Lunch at the Cove
1:00 – 2:00	Hike to Ridgeline Classroom Wilderness First Aid Lesson & games
2:00 – 3:00	Wildlife Safety, Food Caching, and Shelter Building
3:15 – 3:30	Walk back to MLC Wrap up & Goodbyes
3:30 – 4:00	Load bus
4:00 – 4:30	Bus from the Millard Learning Centre to Sturdies Bay
5:45 PM	Ferry departs for Tsawwassen Terminal
6:40 PM	Ferry arrives at Tsawwassen Ferry Terminal.
