11:55 – 12:30	Lunch
12:30-1:00	Energy transformations with the Energy Game!
1:00- 1:45	Bike Bonanza! Hope on our Generator bike and see what you can power by peddling!
1:45-2:00	Snack Break
2:00– 3:00	Properties of light, Solar thermal
3:00-4:00	Multi-meters, Circuits, and Solar Photo Voltaic!
4:00-4:15	Wrap up set up for Camping

Day 3: Marine Investigations

7:30 – 8:00	Wake-up
8:00 – 9:20	Breakfast & Clean-up
9:20 – 10:00	Gear take-down, personal gear pack-up & learning centre clean-up and Pack day bag.
10:00-10:30	GCA Staff Arrives and Check in
10:30 – 11:00	Load bus and Drive to Montague Harbour Marine Provincial Park

- 11:00– 11:30** **Introduction to the park, its history and some games!**
- 11:30 – 12:00** **LUNCH** Please note food for lunch and snacks is not provided by Galiano Conservancy
- 12:00 – 1:45** **Shell Beach Intertidal Exploration**
- A live wet lab! Students carefully collect and examine intertidal animals while exploring the rocky intertidal area. Discussion of animal adaptations, phylogeny, habitat & niches, climate and other ecosystem stressors to follow.
- 1:45 – 2:15** **Shell Middens**
- Guided thought-activities surrounding 3000+ history of Sum’nuw, its people and their traditions
- 2:15 – 2:45** **Walk to Dock Beach**
- 2:45 – 3:00** **SNACK**
- 3:00 – 4:00** **Dock Teaching Train**
- Students teach their peers about cool adaptations and wacky underwater lifestyles of intertidal and subtidal species at their “train station” on the dock.
- 4:00 – 4:30** **Wrap Up & Goodbyes**
- 4:30 – 4:45** **Drive to Sturdies Bay ferry terminal Ferry departs Galiano Island for Tsawwassen terminal** Ferry typically departs Galiano 15-30 minutes later for Victoria.
