11:45 – 12:05	Drive from Sturdies Bay to the Millard Learning Centre (MLC) Need on-island transportation? Rent our bus! Seats up to 54 small students or 36 adults.
12:05 - 12:20	Welcome & Site Introduction
12:20 - 12:50	Lunch
12:50 - 1:30	Forage Forest introduction and Restoration Activity Our Nuts'a'maat Forage Forest is a restoration area that was once clear cut and now has been re-planted with edible and medicinal native plants for visitors and the community to benefit from.
1:30 - 1:50	Cultivation activity
1:50 - 2:00	Snack break
2:00 -3:15	5 Senses Activity- Nature Journal to record your findings Students will get up close and personal with interesting native plants! By using all their senses they will identify and record information about specific plants.
3:15 - 3:30	Foraging technique and etiquette
3:30 - 4:00	Walk on the ridge trail to harvest plants for making native tea
4:00 - 4:45	Set up drying tea and make take home tea bags Each student will make a personal tea mix and take home a tea bag to enjoy later or a gift to remember their experience on Galiano.
4:45 – 5:15	Wrap up and feedback
