- 12:50 - 1:30**                    **Forage Forest introduction and Restoration Activity**  
Our Nuts'a'maat Forage Forest is a restoration area that was once clear cut and now has been re-planted with edible and medicinal native plants for visitors and the community to benefit from.
- 1:30 - 1:50**                    **Cultivation activity**
- 1:50 - 2:00**                    **Snack break**
- 2:00 -3:15**                    **5 Senses Activity- Nature Journal to record your findings**  
Students will get up close and personal with interesting native plants! By using all their senses they will identify and record information about specific plants.
- 3:15 - 3:30**                    **Foraging technique and etiquette**
- 3:30 - 4:00**                    **Walk on the ridge trail to harvest plants for making native tea**
- 4:00 - 4:45**                    **Set up drying tea and make take home tea bags**  
Each student will make a personal tea mix and take home a tea bag to enjoy later or a gift to remember their experience on Galiano.
