

## AN ISLAND OF WONDERS

Touch a live sea star, make a Douglas-fir salve and camp under the stars! Escape to nature with eight single day and overnight field trip options flexible to suit your learning needs.



### FIELD TRIP OPTIONS

MARINE INVESTIGATIONS (SINGLE DAY, GRADES K-12) Grab your specimen buckets to discover the amazing adaptations of rocky shore intertidal creatures. Learn about the rich cultural history of Sum'nuw (Montague Harbour).

COASTAL FORESTS (SINGLE DAY, GRADES 4-12) How do mature forests combat climate change? Pull a tree down with your bare hands as a part of a forest thinning restoration project, plus lunch at beautiful Pebble Beach!

QUEST FOR THE MOUNTAIN TOP (SINGLE DAY. GRADES 4-12)Soak up breathtaking views on top of Mt. Galiano's peak. Remove invasive plants to restore endangered Garry Oak meadows.

FOOD FOREST WONDERLAND (SINGLE DAY. GRADES K-12) Get your hands dirty at the Food Forest while engaging in permaculture gardening, hot composting and pollinator habitat protection.

NATIVE PLANT INSPIRATIONS (SINGLE DAY. GRADES K-12) Tune into your senses. Learn how to identify, harvest and use local native plants for food and medicines. Take home samples of what you make.

RENEWABLE ENERGY IN ACTION (SINGLE DAY OR OVERNIGHT, GRADES 3-12) Experiment with solar and wind renewable energy technologies, learn how energy relates to ecosystem health and climate change.

BACKCOUNTRY EXPERIENCE (SINGLE DAY OR OVERNIGHT, GRADES 4-12) Step into Galiano's wilderness and master the basics of hiking, camping and outdoor survival.

BUILD YOUR OWN OVERNIGHT EXPERIENCE! Designed for the undecided! Mix and match different programs and sleep overnight at the Millard Learning Centre's Frontcountry or Backcountry Campgrounds.

### ACCOMODATIONS

Camp at the Millard Learning Centre, our 188acre environmental education hub. With 5km of trails and a sunset-facing beach, the Learning Centre is the perfect nature-getaway for kids and adults alike. Choose from 2 campgrounds.



#### FRONTCOUNTRY CAMPGROUND

This "glamp"-site has 24h access to the Classroom Building which has a full kitchen, dining hall, showers, flush toilets and wifi.

45 campers or 18 tents max.

#### BACKCOUNTRY CAMPGROUND

Tucked off the beaten path, this campsite offers a great intro to sleeping in the woods and includes basic amenities. 36 campers or 12 tents max.



FEES & BURSARIES

\$32/participant per day

10 participants minimum, 40 maximum. PROGRAM Up to 5 adult chaperones free (additional chaperones charged same as participants)



Frontcountry Campground - \$350/night Includes 24h use of Classroom Building

Backcountry Campground - \$80/night
