HOW TO GET FUNDING FOR YOUR TRIPS

Daytrippers Children's Charity is excited to partner with you to bring experiential learning opportunities to all students.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- Applications must be for a Canadian school, and classes must be grades K-8. Daytrippers does not fund high school trips.
- All trip reimbursement requests, including in-class, virtual, or off-site experiences, must be expressed in Canadian currency. Should your trip supplier charge in a foreign currency, please ensure that all receipts/ invoices include the Canadian dollar equivalent paid.
- Schools must clearly demonstrate need for financial assistance.
- Trip requests must align with ministry curriculum. When unclear, a member of our team may seek clarification from you.
- Amount requested must not exceed \$25/child to a maximum of \$1500 CAD per application.
- Daytrippers reserves the right to adjudicate all applications at its sole discretion, notwithstanding the above criteria.

APPLY NOW IN 3 EASY STEPS



1. APPLICATION

Once you have ensured that you meet the eligibility criteria, start your application online at daytrippers.ca and click on "Apply for Funding".



2. APPROVAL

Once our team confirms that you meet the eligibility criteria, an email will be sent to the email used in the application confirming the approval of your application.



3. REIMBURSEMENT

Once your trip has taken place, please submit all receipts (proof of payment) via email, and we will reimburse you with a cheque in the mail.
